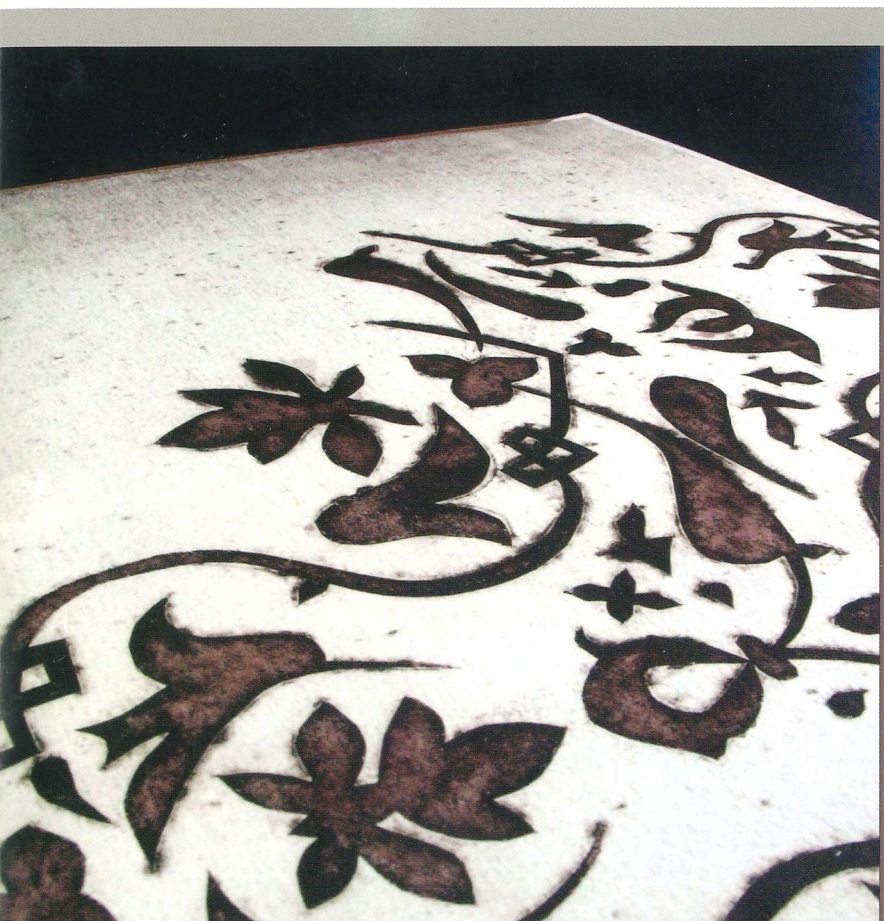

Deanna Hitti was the recipient of Artspace Mackay's *Libris Awards National Artists' Book Award* in 2008. *Assimilated Rhythm No.4 Blint Trembuckey* combines collographs & watercolour to create a large music score - a rhythmic palimpsest of Arabic & Western words generating a lyrical flow of pattern & thought.

TWELVE DEGREES OF LATITUDE: REGIONAL GALLERY & UNIVERSITY ART COLLECTIONS IN QUEENSLAND

McAleese Gallery and Foyer, 28 May - 11 July 2010

Twelve Degrees of Latitude is the first major exhibition of works curated solely from the collections of twenty-seven of Queensland's regional gallery & university collections. The exhibition focuses on why & how Queensland's regional collections began, their historical roles within their communities, the role of patronage and donor support in their growth & development, & the strength of the state-wide regional gallery culture.

The exhibition illustrates the diversity, as well as significant linkages, of regional collections through themes or groupings such as pre-20th century art; landscape & figures in landscape; other 20th century art (1900-1990); indigenous art; & art post 1990.

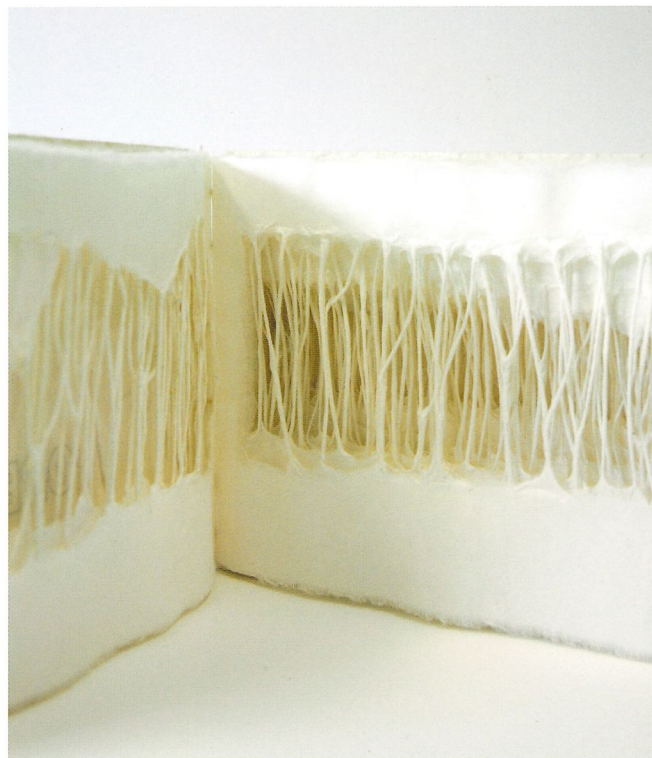

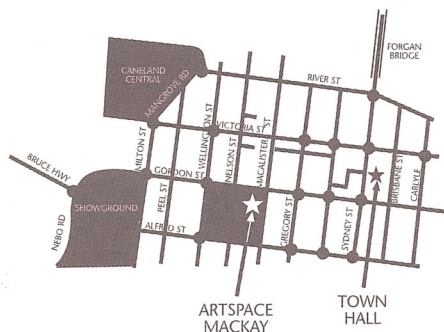
